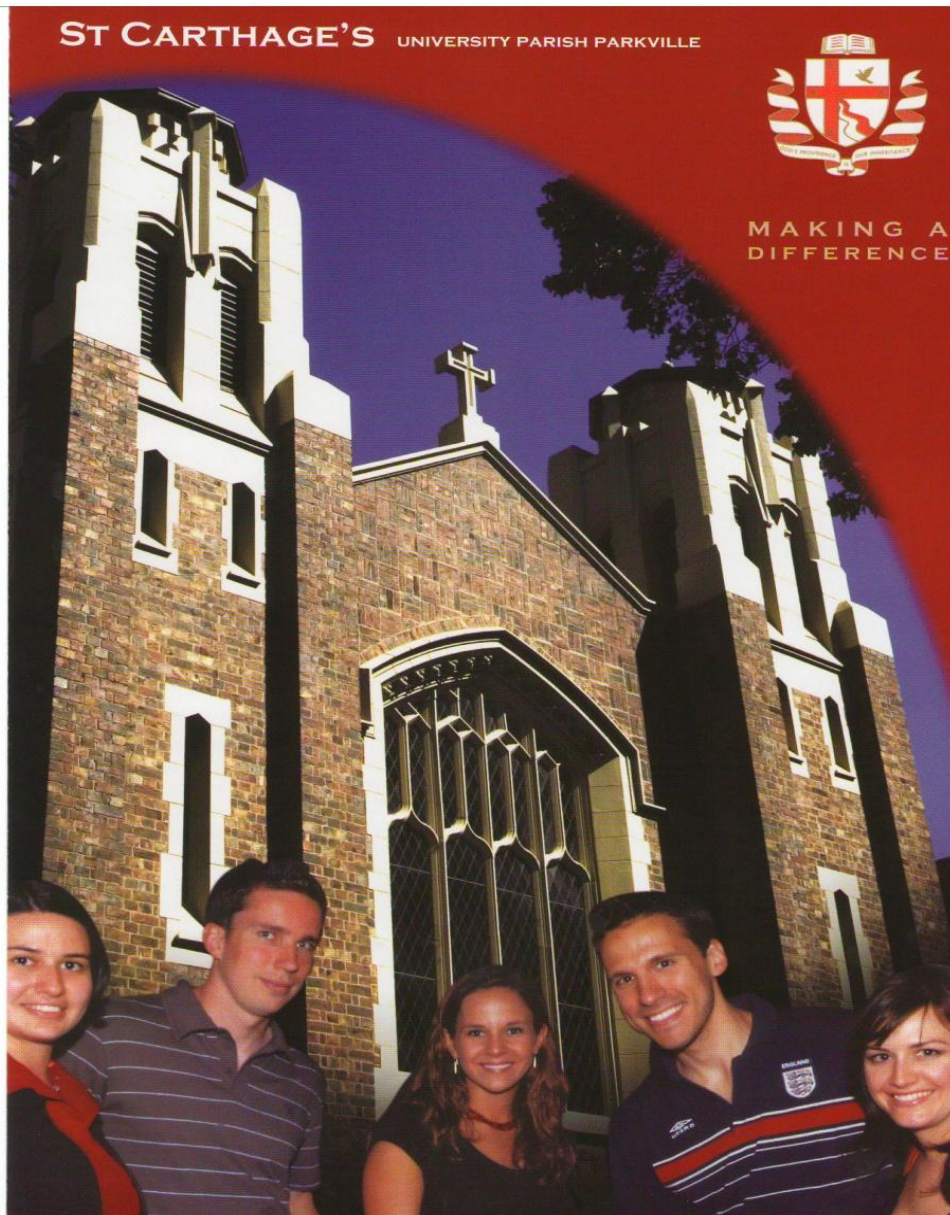

## History of the Book: Future Directions

At a time when information is increasingly a digital commodity, the long history of the book from the first codices through the introduction and spread of printing is ever more important; with research libraries and their unique and rare holdings bearing witness to the development of ideas. Distinguished book historians Professor David McKitterick, Dr Patrick Spedding and Dr Stephanie Downes will shed light on new directions in their discipline, showing how books and the people who made, collected or read them tell through their stories much about the history of human thought.

**Professor David McKitterick** is the Emeritus Honorary Professor of Historical Bibliography, Trinity College, Cambridge. **Dr Patrick Spedding** is the Associate Director, Centre for the Book, Monash University. **Dr Stephanie Downes** is the Post-Doctoral Research Fellow at the University of Melbourne in the Australian Research Council's Centre of Excellence for the History of Emotions.

# St Carthage's Asylum Seekers Support

Back in October last year our parish ran a most successful Trivia Night that brought together a wide range of parishioners and friends.



As a result the event raised \$4,300.00. This money was passed on to support St Vincent de Paul outreach to people in need.

In turn \$2,000.00 was allocated to The Brigidine Asylum Seekers Project.

In a letter of appreciation they outlined how the money was used.

\$600.00 assisted an Iranian family of a father, mother and two children. After two years on Nauru they were transferred to a detention centre in Broadmeadows for post trauma treatment including major depression. A house has been found for them but they had no money for further professional support. This funding has given them hope.

The remaining money was used to assist a Ugandan man and his three sons 10, 7 and 4 Year old. Initial rental accommodation was found as they await assistance through the Red Cross.

Our fun night has helped lift the burden for desperate people.
