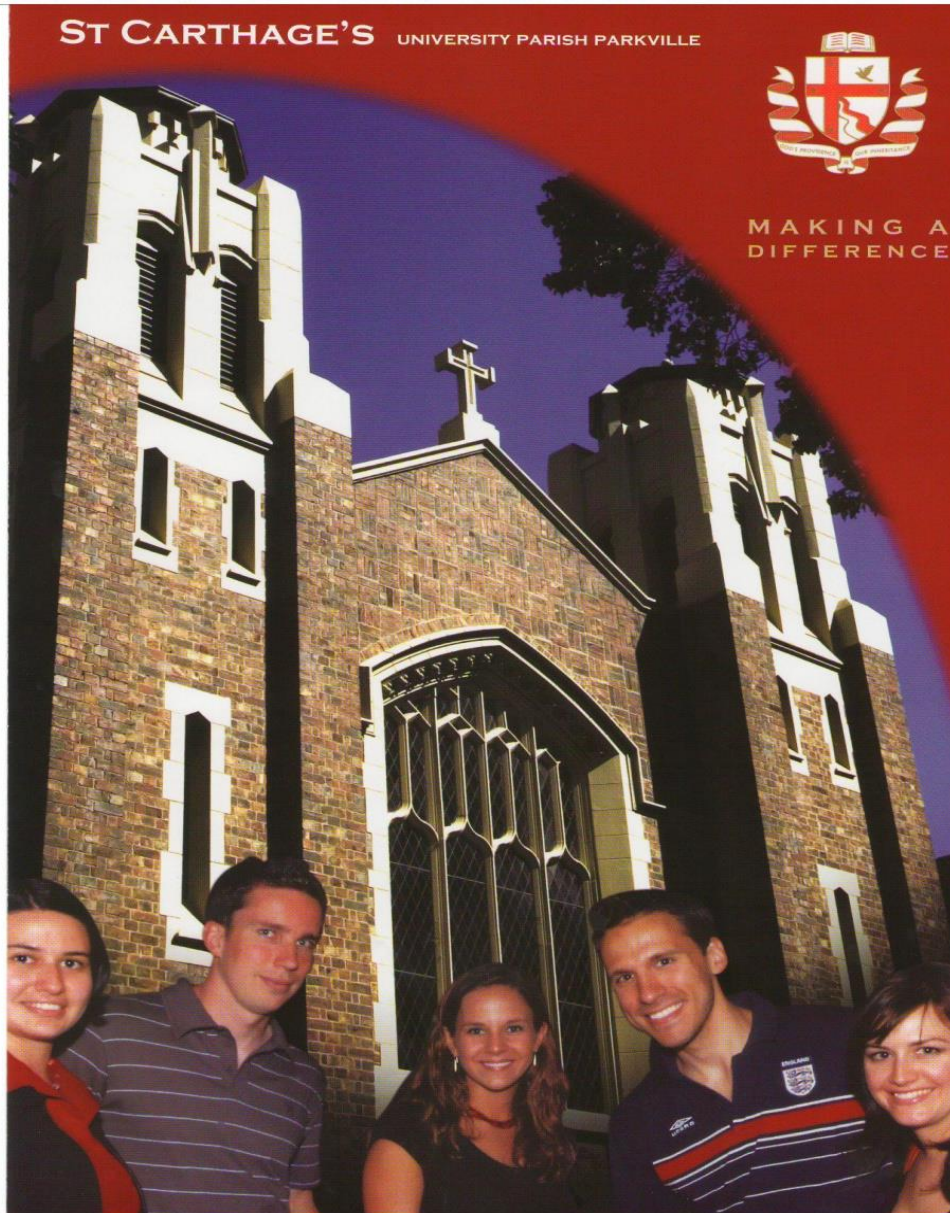

*Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> April at 2:30pm*

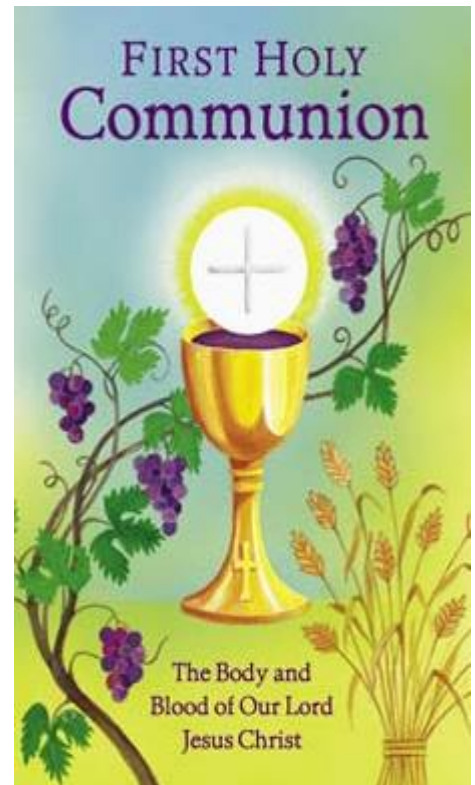
*Mass, seating allocation plus preparation session.*

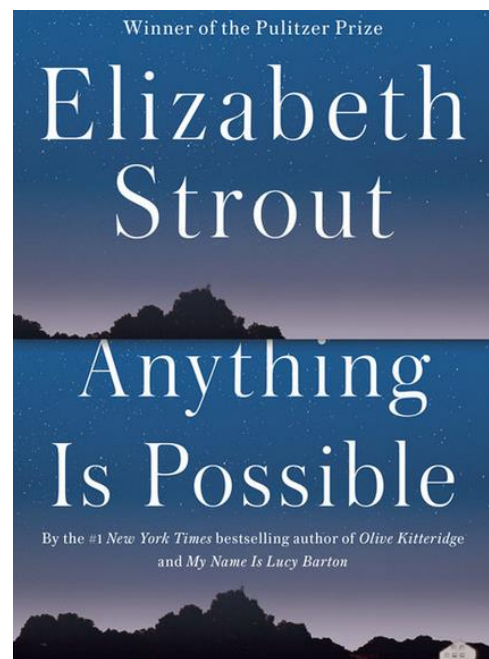

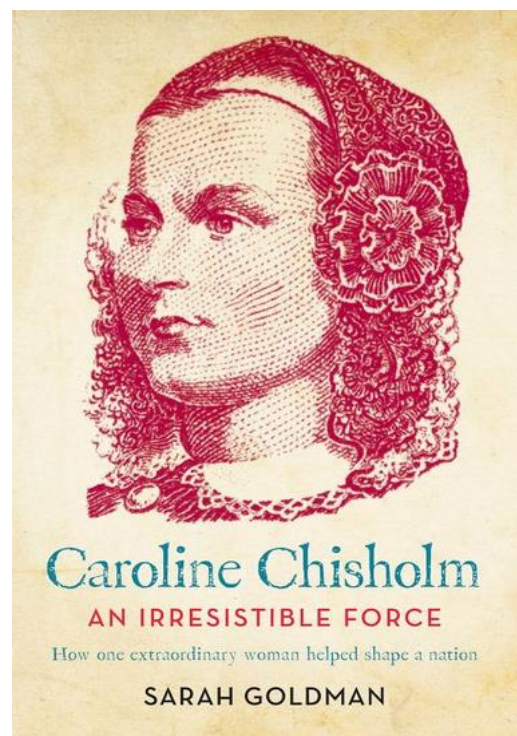
