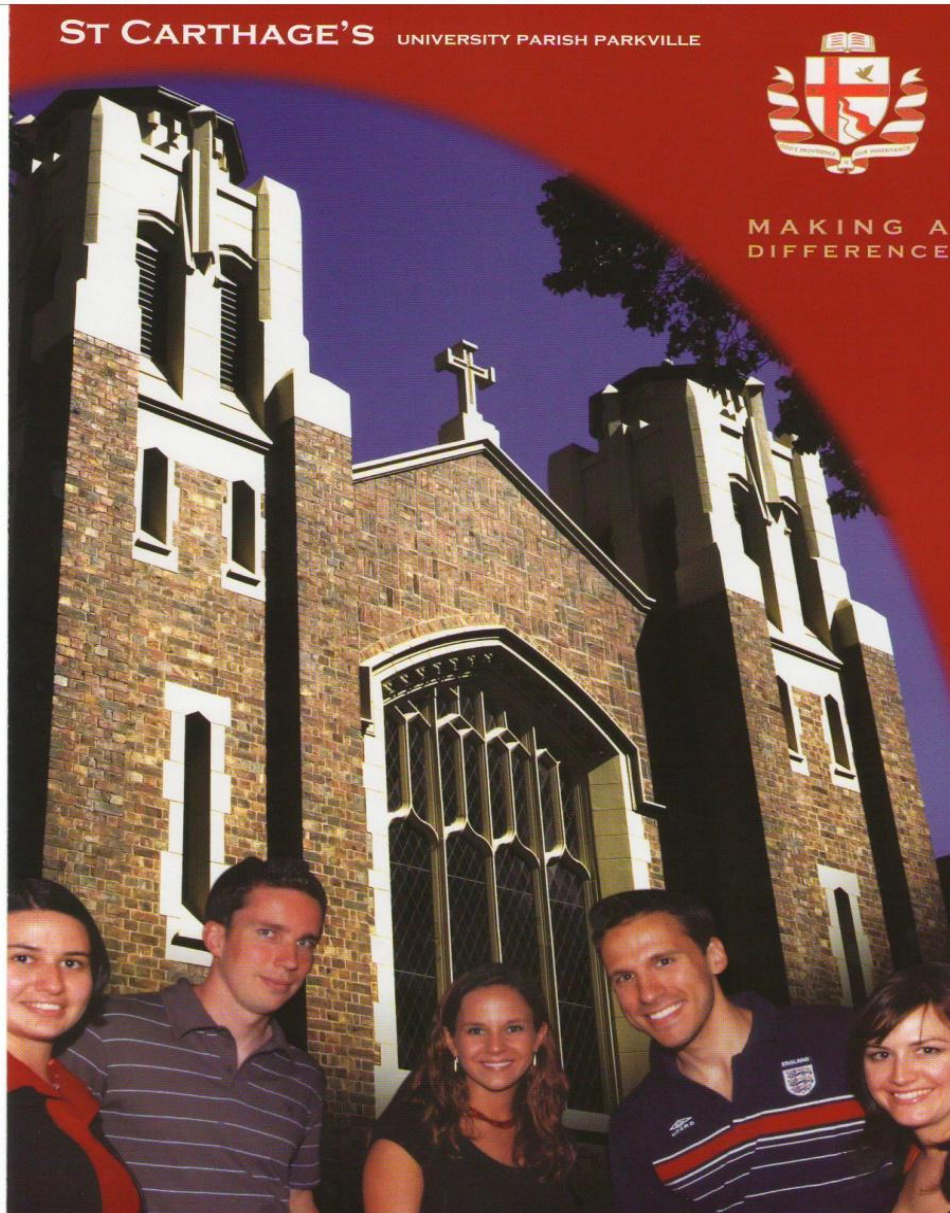

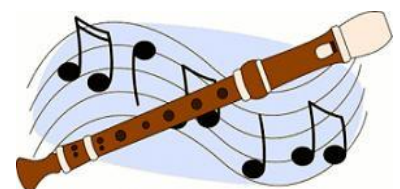

The eighty two parishioners who registered their names with Berise Heasley and Mary Williams will receive their tickets at the Masses this weekend.




# Follow up to the Royal Commission on Sexual Abuse

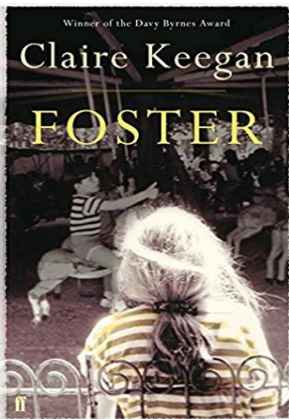
