The Crane Bag.

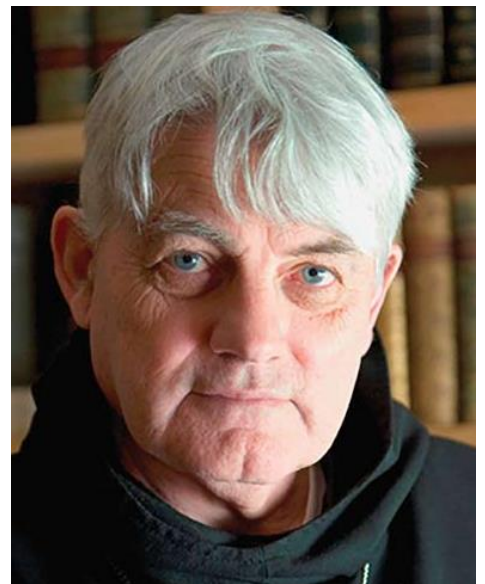

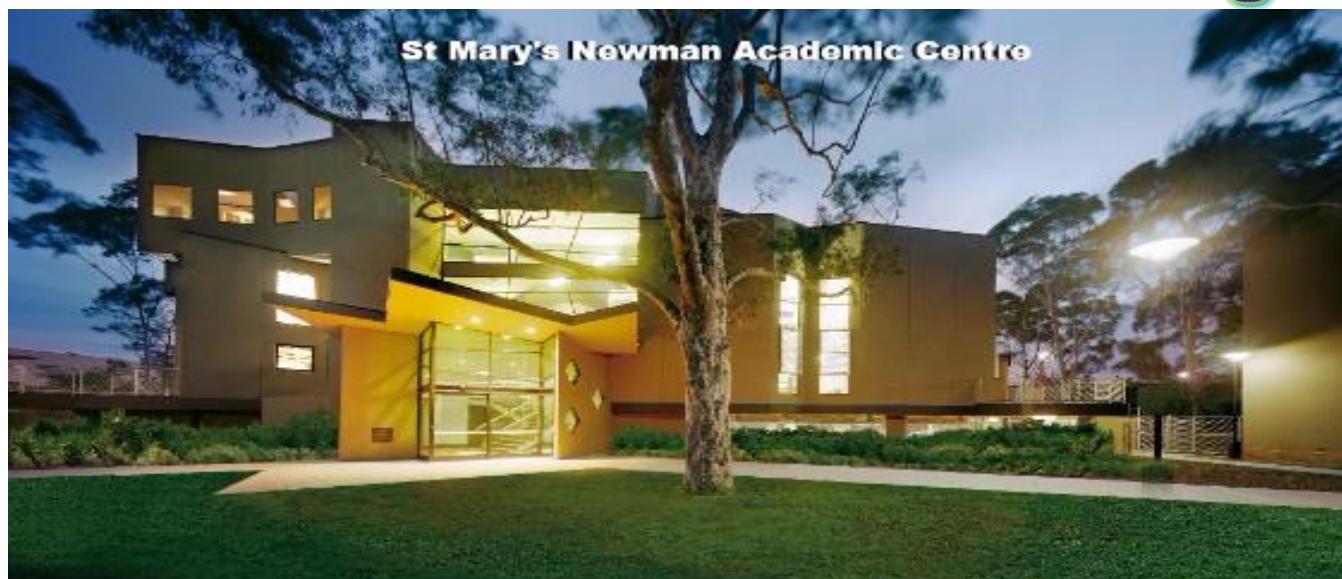
