

Why was it necessary & what is it doing?

Kevin has just completed 14 years as Parish Priest of St Mary's Parish, Geelong and is now PP of St Simon's Parish, Rowville. Ordained as a priest of the Archdiocese for 46 years, he still maintains strong family links with his three siblings and meets with them most Sundays, in a Glen Waverley café. This, he says, keeps him grounded. Kevin's sense of social justice, he attributes to his father, Sir John Dillon, who was Victoria's first ombudsman.



Kevin believes the years he spent talking to Vietnam War veterans who were suffering post-traumatic stress disorder have helped him

recognise and respond to the long-term suffering in survivors of sexual abuse.
