

DEALING WITH TRAUMA, LOSS and GRIEF

Dr Annie Cantwell-Bartl has a long background in supporting people after loss, as well as having her own experience of profound loss. Formerly a palliative care nurse at Caritas Christi, and a worker at Corpus Christi with homeless men, she conducted research interviews with 700 terminal cancer patients or their carers. Her Doctorate was on parents of children expected to die of congenital heart defects.

Now a psychologist and psychotherapist, she was involved with counselling people after the Bourke St car rampage in January 2017. Earlier, she was awarded the media prize from the National Association for Loss and Grief for an article in *the Age* on her mother's stroke.

Then again on Sunday 24th September at 11:15am. Families will choose what confirmation Mass suits them at the time of enrolment.




Guest Reflection Speakers

Parishioner **Dr Annie Cantwell-Bartl**, a psychologist and psychotherapist with long experience assisting traumatised and grieving people, spoke on *Grief and Love* at 10 am Mass last week.

Annie reminded us of how many things give rise to grief, and that it is both healthy and therapeutic to share your inner feelings with others. She spoke of a major grief experience in her own life, and how nearly thirty years later a black wall of despair has become a life-affirming, positive situation. Reflections on Jesus' grief - and what caused it - helps affirm our faith and our own wellbeing.
