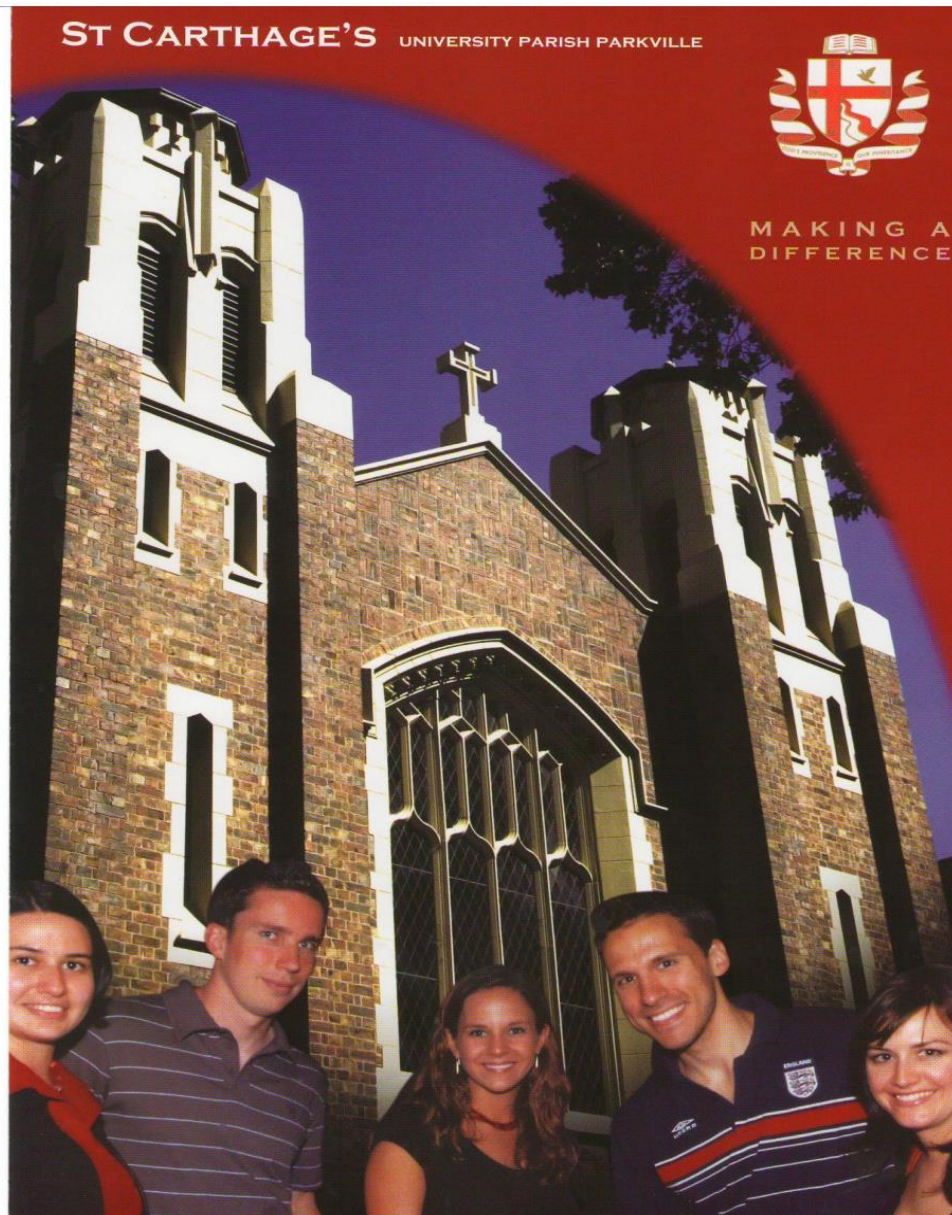

** The St Carthage's Music Group will lead the singing at the 5pm Student Mass.*

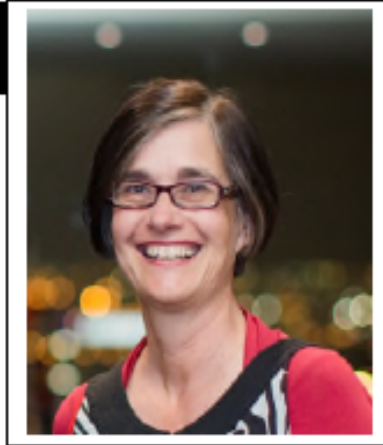

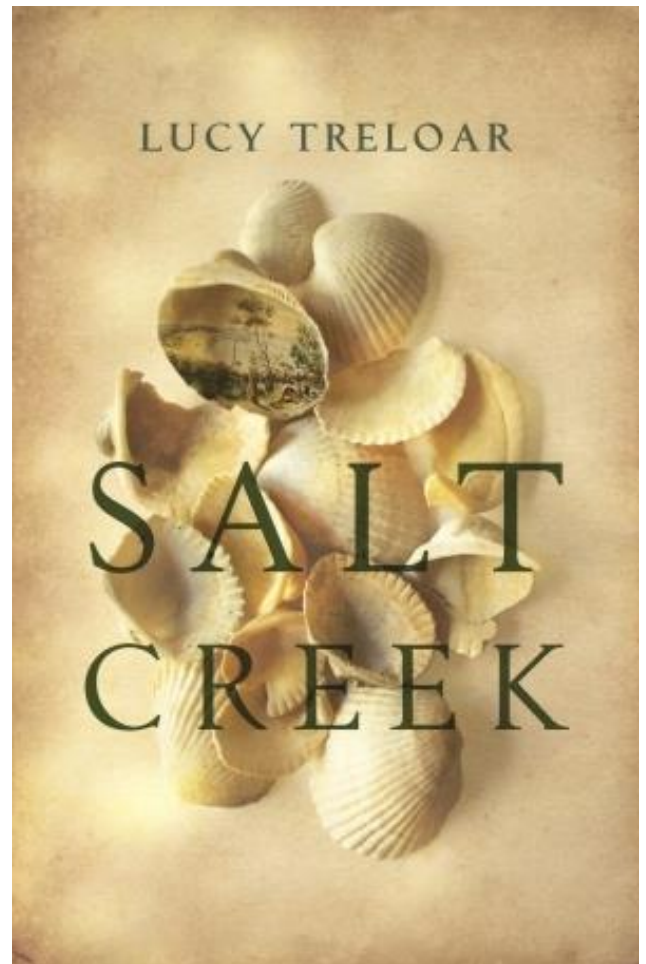

Maryanne Confoy is a member of the Congregation of the Australian Sisters of Charity and a Professor of Pastoral Theology at Pilgrim College (University of Divinity). She has written several books, including a biography of

the international author Morris West. She has lectured, given workshops, and engaged in consultancy work. She is a Trustee of Edmund Rice Education Australia, a Board Member of St Vincent's Health Australia and of The Way Community for Homeless Men.

Lecture 2: Monday 5th March 2018

The Eucharist and Ethics: From Worship to Christian Formation and Social Action



Rev. Dr Hoa Trung Dinh SJ lectures in moral theology, bioethics and sexual ethics at the Catholic Theological College. A medical graduate from Melbourne University (MBBS, 1993), he holds theology degrees from the MCD, Weston Jesuit School of Theology, and Boston

College. His doctoral research focused on the virtue-based approach to medical ethics. He is a priest of the Society of Jesus in Australia.

Ignatian Spirituality and a time of conflict



Fr Andy Hamilton SJ is a Jesuit priest, writer at Jesuit Communications and Jesuit Social Services, and has also had a long-standing engagement with refugee communities and issues. Andy taught theology at the United Faculty of Theology for
