Rotary Club of Carlton is again conducting a ROTARY BOOK FAIR ON Saturday 5 May & Sunday, 6 May 2018.


The Book Fair will be held at Kathleen Syme Library & Community Centre, 251 Faraday Street, Carlton 3053


Please drop your books, vinyl's, CD's DVD's you no longer read, look at/listen to, etc. into the Donation Box located near the entry of St Carthages.
