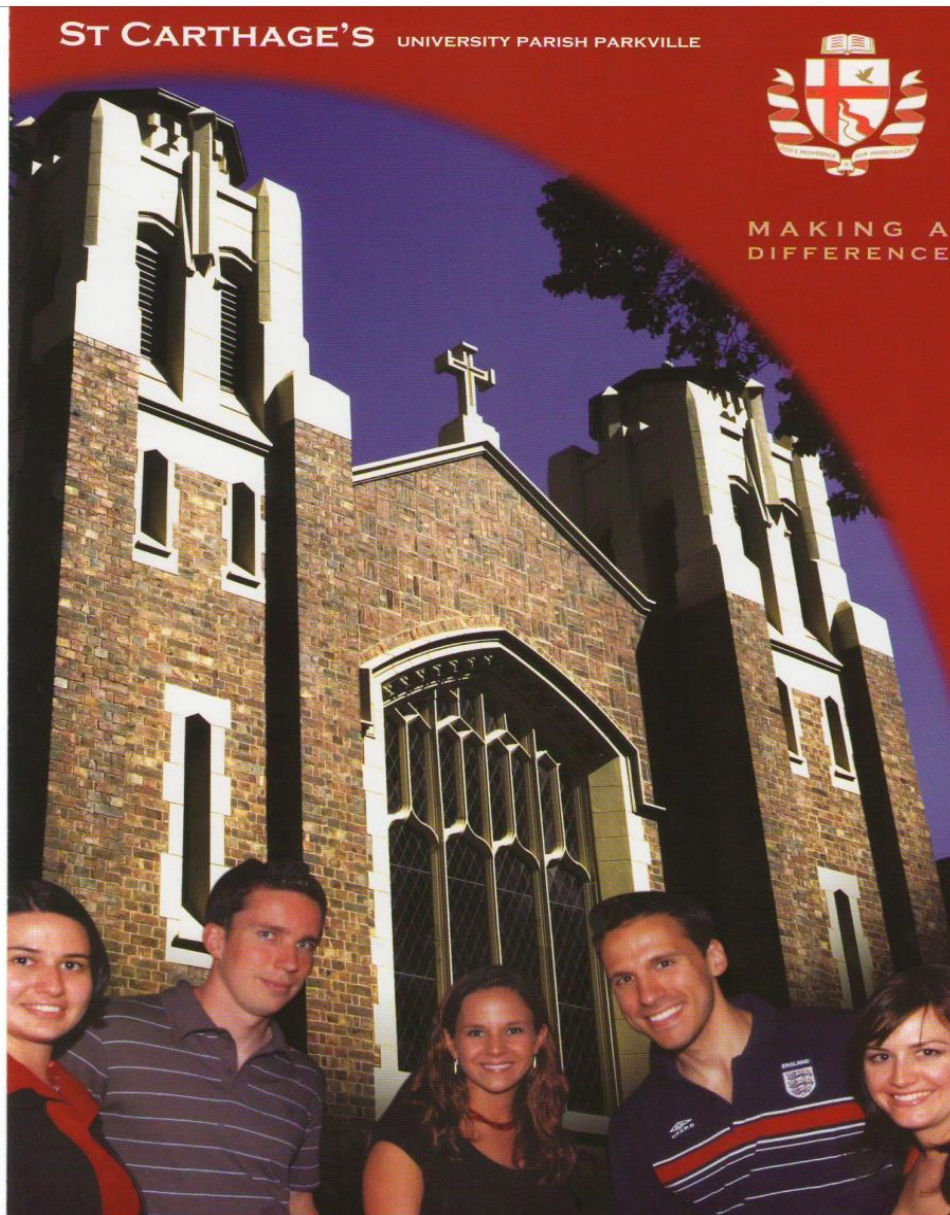

SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY PRKVILLE CONFERENCE NEEDS NEW VOLUNTEER MEMBERS

Our small group who visit disadvantaged individuals and families in the Parkville and Carlton areas needs new volunteer members.

Our work is altruistic and rewarding. We visit individuals and families who have made a - sometimes desperate - plea to the StVdeP phone-helpline for food, basic furniture or clothing. We visit these people in teams of two and give them food vouchers and/or organise the delivery of furniture, household items, clothing etc. from StVdeP op-shops and other suppliers.

We are experiencing an increase in demand for our services in 2017 and we now would welcome new volunteer members:

- Two volunteers willing to give **two hours per fortnight** during daytime on Saturdays
- Two volunteers willing to give two **hours per fortnight** during daytime Mondays-Fridays

The only pre-requisites are a willingness to help disadvantaged individuals and families, a good degree of compassion and attendance at our monthly meetings on the second Monday of each month.

New volunteers would join our visitations team and be given an introduction and training with an experienced volunteer for a few months before making visits with a regular partner.

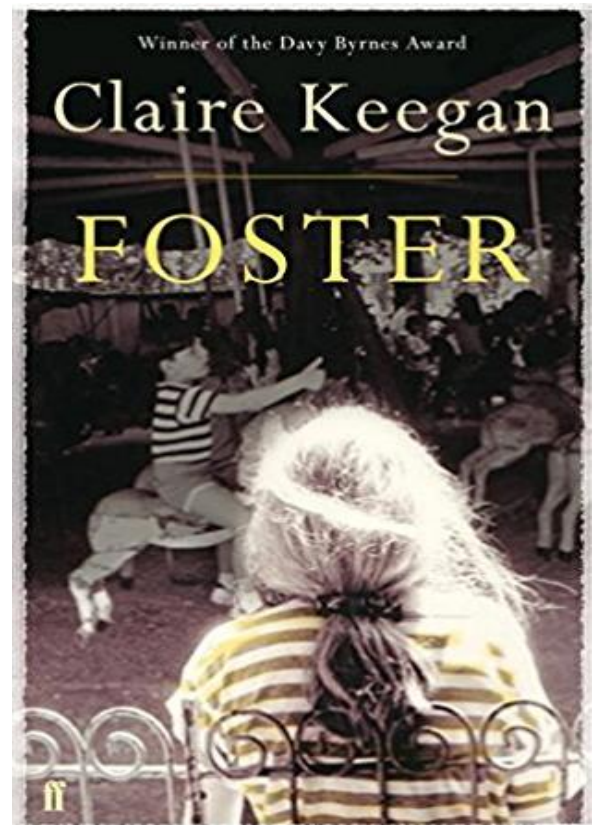

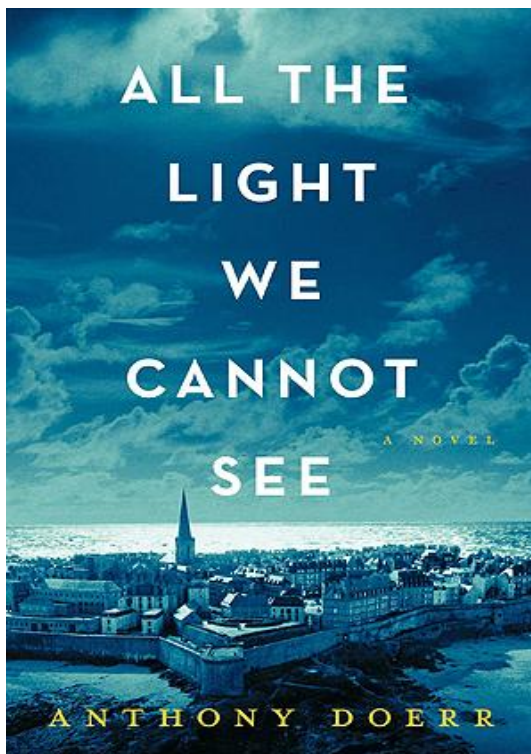
