



Michael McGirr is the dean of faith at St Kevin's College, a large Edmund Rice school in Melbourne. His latest work, BOOKS THAT SAVED MY LIFE (Text Publishing) is about the sheer joy of living, exploring forty texts that can enrich us in all manner of ways.
