#### Trivia Night

We are happy to announce that the final profit from the Trivia Night is \$3,402.50 The money from Try Booking has now also been banked. The funds will be given to our St Vincent de Paul conference this week.



At last the long list of City Council & State Occupational Health & Safety requirements have all been approved.

Robert Simeoni our architect has received approval for his design for the grounds and the toilet block at the rear of the Church.

The Concrete path on the Brunswick side of the Church has to be replaced by a wider wheel chair access path. The rear Church grounds have to have a safe slope to the toilet block, and the toilets need to be safe and accessible. While the initial quote accepted from tenders is \$93,000, a provision has to be made for extra expense if tree roots have substantially blocked pipes to the main sewer and drainage mains. A temporary toilet will be available on the

northern side of the church near the existing gate.

Recent past contributions have substantially paid for the work. This money is held in reserve. Our Financial Committee has recommended. We take out a loan to cover unforeseen expenses and for the day to day viability of the Parish Budget.
