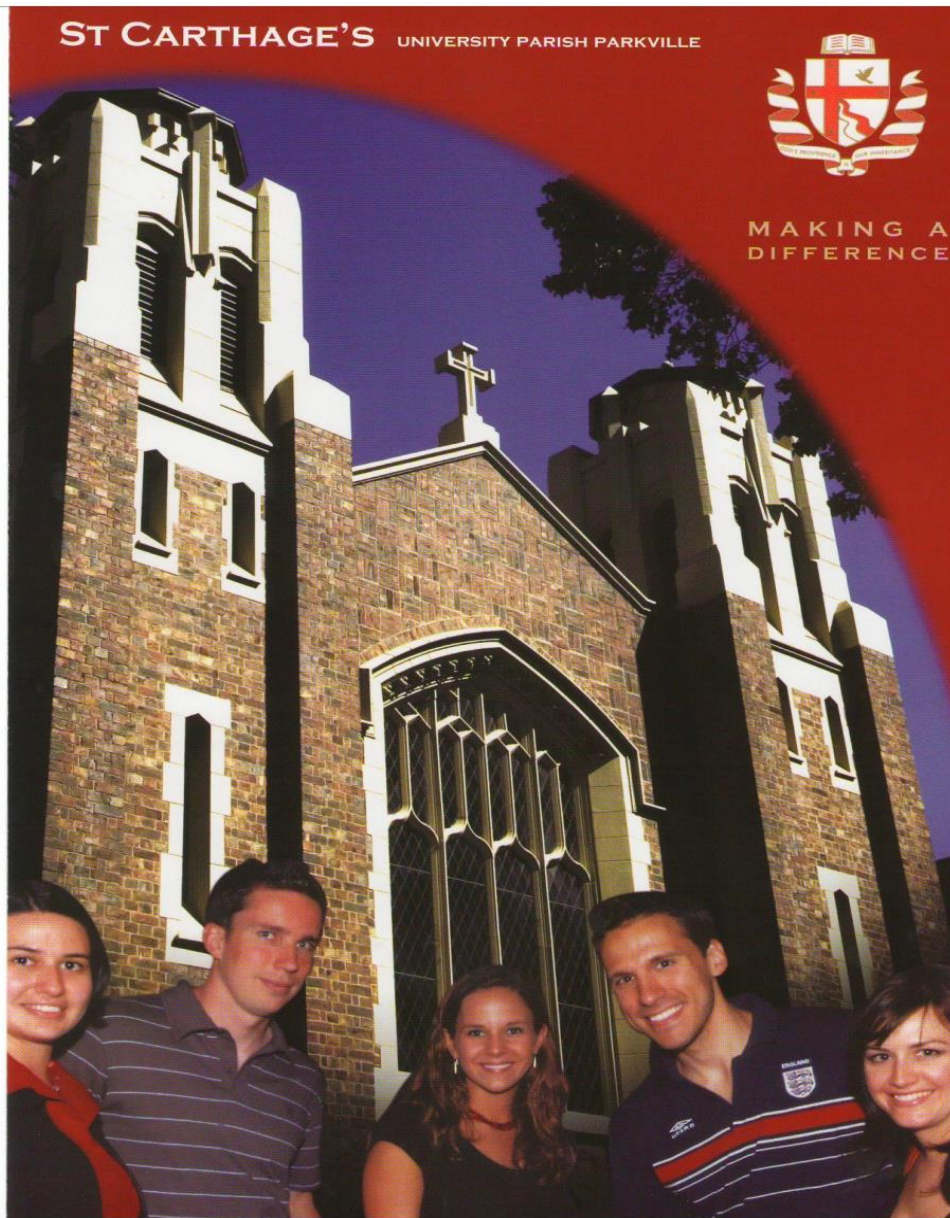

The Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation will be part of a special 2:15pm Mass.

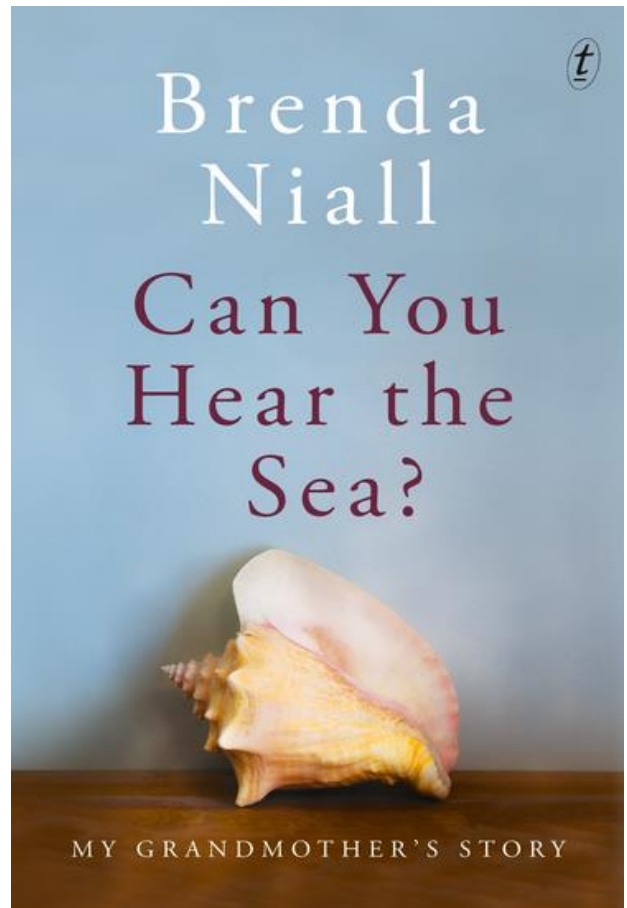
