## REPORT FROM THE COMMITTEE PREPARING SUBMISSIONS TO THE 2020 PLENARY COUNCIL

The St Carthages process started with a meeting of twelve or so parishioners at the Parish Centre on 22 September. Another ten parishioners could not attend but wanted to be part of the process by email. The next meeting on 14 November, with a similar number taking part, considered the draft submissions members of the group had prepared. This meeting also discussed how to give other parishioners a chance to read and comment on the draft submissions. The objective is to see if we can get wider endorsement from the parish of the draft submissions. This is to give them greater weight than the current plenary council process which only encourages individual submissions.

The following draft submissions have been prepared. In the next few weeks, we plan to circulate 500 word summaries of these submissions for wider feedback from parishioners.

- Chris Pearson has contributed 'Some Pre-Plenary Council Reflections', 'Some Changes Required in Priestly Formation' and 'A Local Model of Priestly Ministry'.
- Margaret O'Connor has written a paper on the reforms needed for seminary training.
- Mark Dohrmann has provided a submission on the governance reform needed from the parish level up.
- Mike Angley has written on 'setting measures to monitor progress'.
- Richard and Jan Curtain have written a two-part draft submission on 'Governance in the Catholic Church in Australia: a view from the parish'.
- Damian Ireland has also contributed a 'Submission to the Catholic Bishops Plenary Council'.
