

We need 3 counters to count the collection money after the 5pm Sunday Mass.


We hope to have enough volunteers that means a roster turn every two months.

 Counting usually takes between forty minutes and one hour.


 We plan to have a thank you drinks in early february that will bring our volunteers together. We will also give a practical demonstration of the counting procedure.


