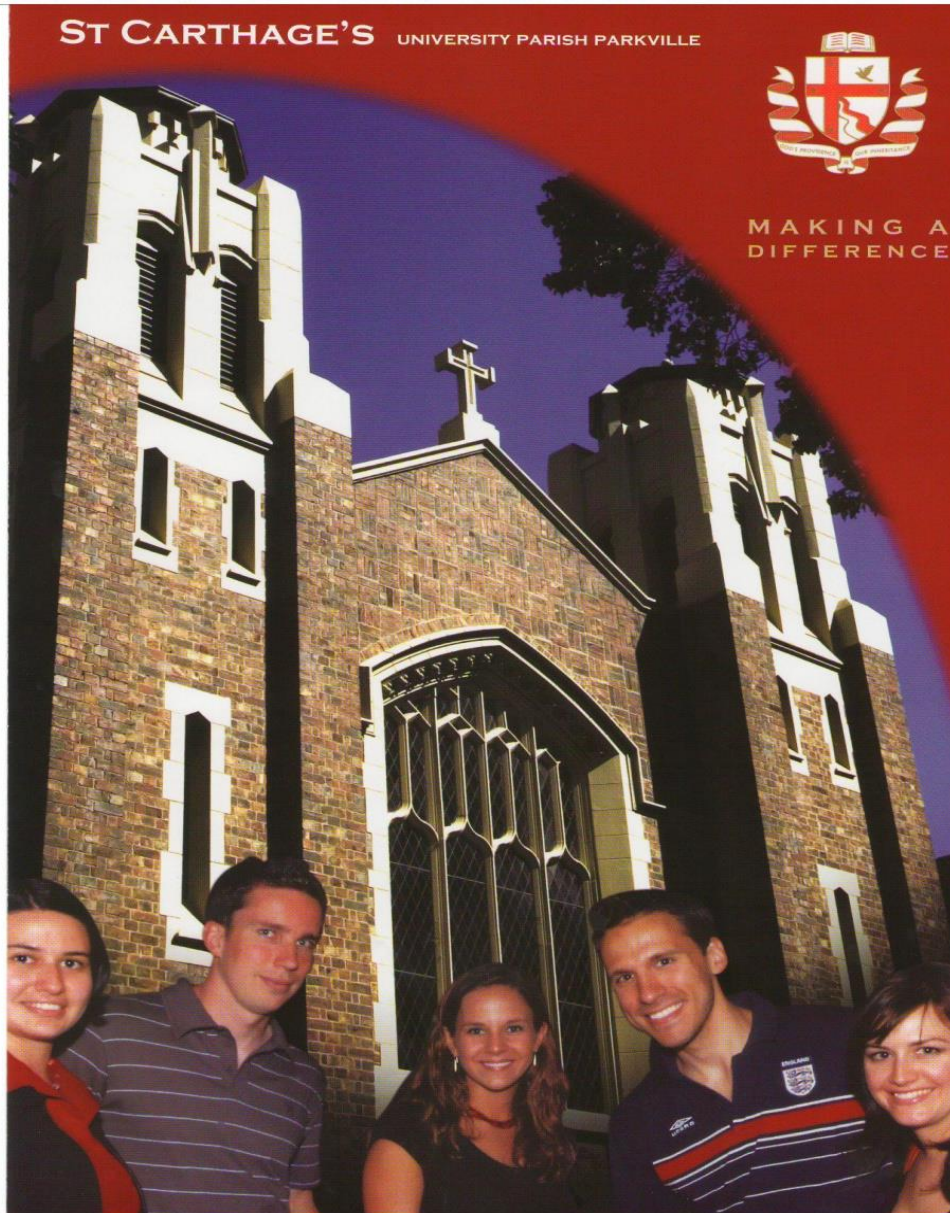

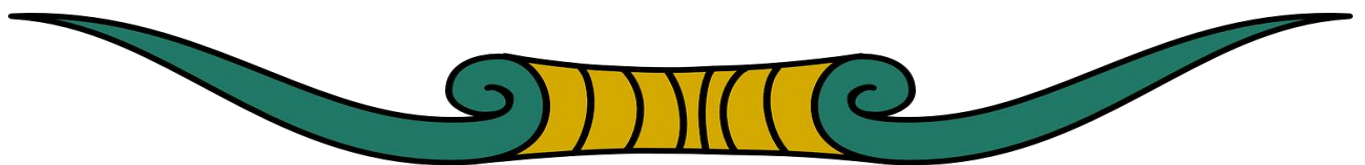

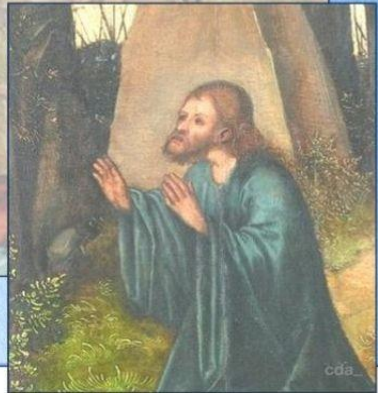
Wine Raffle at the Parish Dinner
