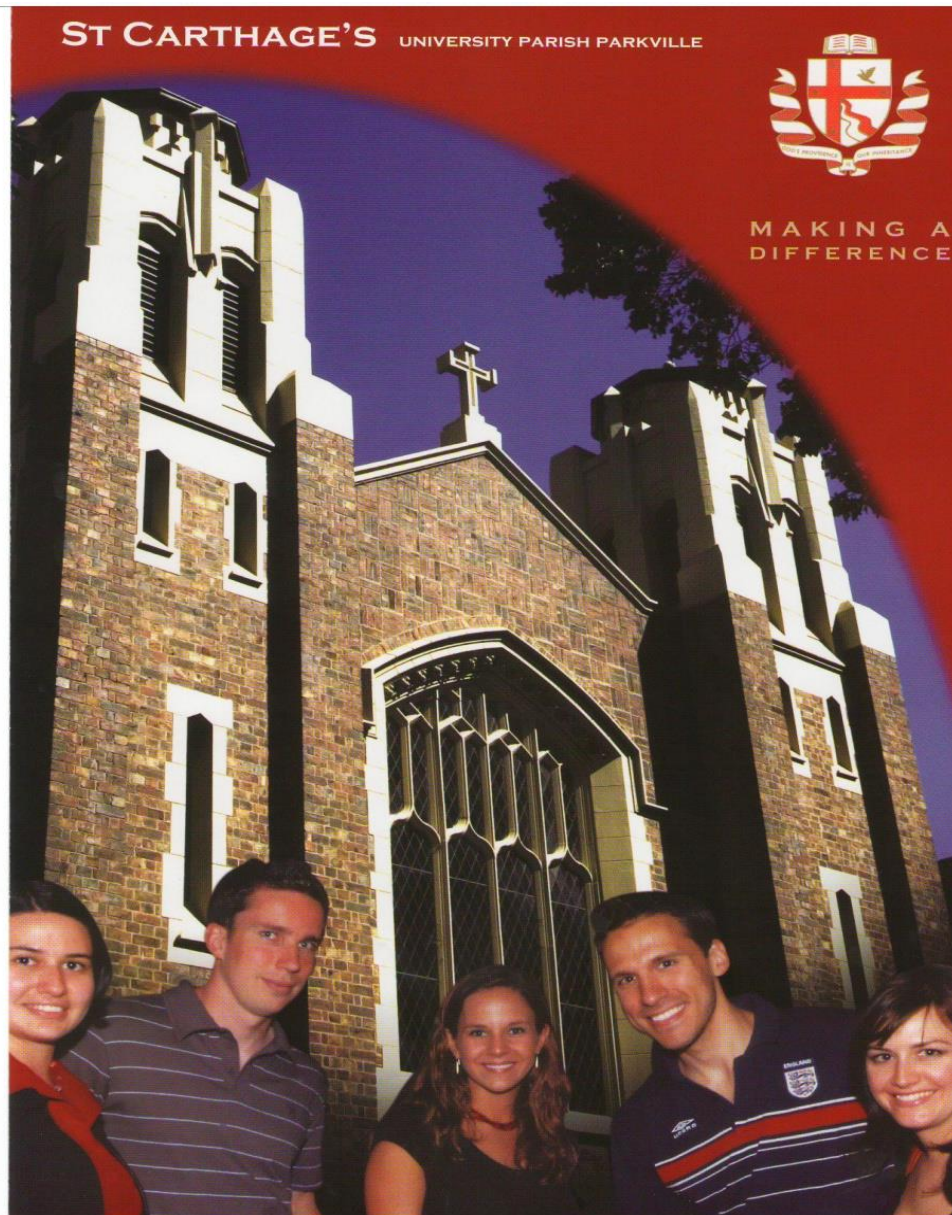

A record crowd of parishioners and friends gathered recently to raise funds for our St Vincent de Paul Christmas Appeal.

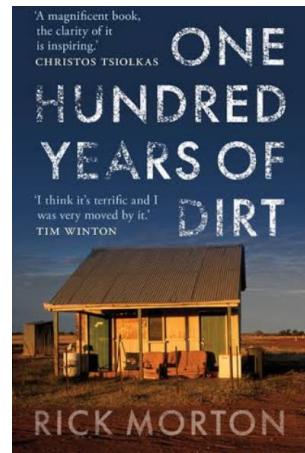

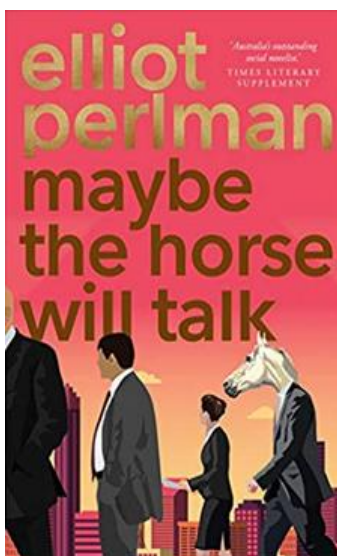
