

The Rotary Club of Carlton is conducting a


ROTARY BOOK FAIR ON SATURDAY 21 MARCH & SUNDAY 22 MARCH 2020


Please drop your books, vinyls, CDs, DVDs you no longer read, look at /listen to....etc, into the Donation Box located in the church porch.


