

Our St Vincent de Paul Conference here in Parkville will run a Second Hand Book Fair.




The books will sell at bargain prices ranging from novels, biography and historical perspectives.

Fr. Michael wishes to continue to disperse a major part of his personal library prior to retiring from Parish Priest responsibilities.






