Australia's fifth Plenary Council officially gets underway this Sunday with the Opening Mass at St Mary's Cathedral in Perth. Close to 300 Plenary members will then gather online for the first of two assemblies, discussing and discerning how to become a more Christ-centred Church.

It's been **84 years since the last Plenary Council** and a few years since this journey towards the Council began (plus a pandemic interrupting the original schedule!), so you'd be forgiven if you're a little rusty on what's in store for this first Assembly.

- * We pray it will aid in the critical need to renew our mother Church in her mission. May our Lord God, in this 5th Plenary Council, bestow wisdom and discernment on all members.
- * May the shared genuine experience of the faithful, both young and old, be heard and used to direct the church.
- * May the result govern a healing of the current crisis of the Church and restore once again her mission towards evangelisation.
