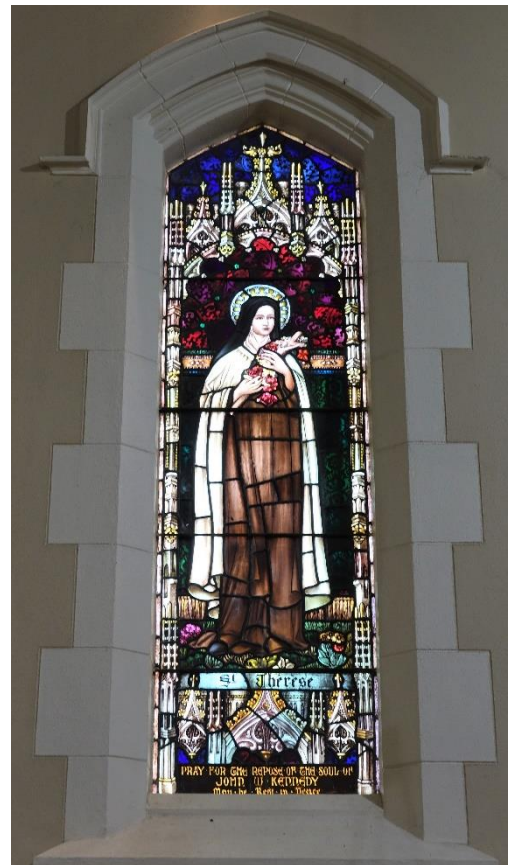

Gospel: [Lk 21:25-28. 34-36](#). Be ready for the second coming.

International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women 25th November

Pope Francis invites us to pray “for a generous welcome of the victims of human trafficking, of enforced prostitution, and of violence.” Abuses and violence against women are “acts of cowardice and a degradation of all humanity,” Pope Francis said. “We

must not look the other way. Let us pray for women who are victims of violence, that they may be protected by society and have their sufferings considered and heeded by all,” he said... “For the financial year 2020/2021, the AFP (Australian Federal Police) received 224 reports of human trafficking, slavery and slavery-like offences. So far this financial year the AFP has received 111 reports,” said Detective Inspector Staunton.

Human trafficking, a \$150 billion global industry, is one of the greatest examples of violence against women and girls.
