

Synod Consultation Sessions Overview



The General Secretariat of the Synod of Bishops has advised that there is an extension of the diocesan consultation phase until August 2022 (previously 17th December 2021).

The Archdiocese will hold two sessions for parish leaders (staff, clergy or volunteers) who are interested to understand the Synod journey and how they might engage and

consult within their own communities.

There two sessions will provide an opportunity to learn more about:

- What is the Synod on Synodality?
- How can we contribute as a local community to the preparatory phase?
- Experience the discernment process as a participant so you might learn to facilitate your own community discernment for the Synod consultation in 2022.

The sessions (same content for each session, repeated at different days/times) will be held on:

- Tuesday November 23rd, 2.00pm 3.30pm
- Thursday November 25th, 7.30 9.00pm
