The sweet, but sometimes-bitter truth about Easter Chocolate. Every Easter Australians spend millions of dollars on chocolate to eat and give away. A 2020 Macquarie University report, *Not-so-sweet:* chocolate, slavery and complicit corporations, found that, "More than two million children under the age of 15yrs work in the cocoa industry in Ivory Coast

and Ghana." A 2021 report by the ILO found that 152 million children are involved in child labour — that's almost one in 10 of all children worldwide. **Help to stop slavery by buying only chocolate that is certified slavery- free?** Look for chocolate with one of the four logos
