INFORMATION SESSION - PERMANENT DIACONATE

Saturday 4 May, at 10.00am at the University of Divinity, Catholic Theological College, 278 Victoria Parade, East Melbourne

In the middle of the pandemic, Pope Francis outlined his prayer for vocations that "deacons, faithful in their service to the Word and the poor, may be an invigorating symbol for the entire Church." He asks everyone to pray for permanent deacons, who live their vocation in and with their family.

He wrote:

Deacons are not second-level priests.

They are part of the clergy and live their vocation in and with their family.

They are dedicated to the service of the poor, who carry within them the face of the suffering Christ.

They are the guardians of service in the Church.

Let us pray that deacons, faithful in their service to the Word and the poor, may be an invigorating symbol for the entire Church.

Pope Francis in his book, "Let us Dream" wrote, 'Permanent deacons are vital to reflecting a domestic Church that finds its greatness in the Word and in service" (p91) In the Archdiocese the permanent diaconate is well established. There are permanent deacons in well over a dozen parishes with a growing number of number of aspirants and candidates in training.

On **Saturday, 4 May 2024, at 10.00am** in University of Divinity, Catholic Theological College, 278 Victoria Parade, East Melbourne VIC, there will be an information session. The session will be presented by some of Melbourne's permanent deacons. It will last no longer than two hours.
