SR NATHALIE BECQUART'S BIOGRAPHY

Sister Nathalie Becquart XMCJ is a French religious sister with the Congregation of Xavières. In May 2019 Pope Francis appointed her Consultor to the Synod of Bishops, and in 2021 he appointed her Undersecretary of the Synod of Bishops, making her the first woman to hold this position in the Vatican and the first woman to be granted voting rights in the Synod of Bishops. Sr Nathalie made significant contributions to both the Synod on Young People in 2018 and the Synod on the Pan-Amazon Region in 2019.
