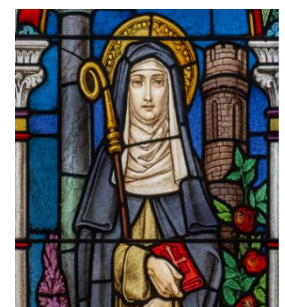
### Welcoming the outsider: Celebrating Brigid and Carthage

**Sun 2 Oct 2.30pm** St Carthage's,  
123 Royal Parade, Parkville.  
Brigid and Carthage (also known  
as Mochuda) were saints of early  
medieval Ireland whose particular  
charism in preaching the Gospel  
included welcoming lepers and  
those considered as outsiders in  
society. This presentation  
celebrates their achievement  
through readings, poetry and  
music. Readings are presented by  
Constant Mews and Chris Watson,  
retired academics from Monash  
and La Trobe Universities  
respectively, who have written  
about their research into these  
saints of early medieval Ireland  
and their influence in Australia.  
Irish music will be provided by  
Cath Connelly, a renowned Celtic  
harper, and Maryna Mews in Irish  
song. Refreshments will be  
provided after the presentation.  
Admission is free, but there will be  
a collection in aid of the Lismore  
Diocese 2022 Flood Appeal (where  
the cathedral is dedicated to St  
Carthage).

### SACRISTANS NEEDED

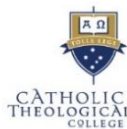
This short time left with Heather can be an opportunity
