Two members of the St Carthage's Financial Council (FC) are due for reappointment after serving 3 years. In considering their reappointment the Parish Council (PC) and Parish Priest seek expression of interest from any other persons interested in serving the Parish through the FC.

The FC reports to the Parish Council (PC), meets a minimum of four times a year, has a minimum of 3 members (current membership) with a maximum of 5 members and has the following responsibilities:

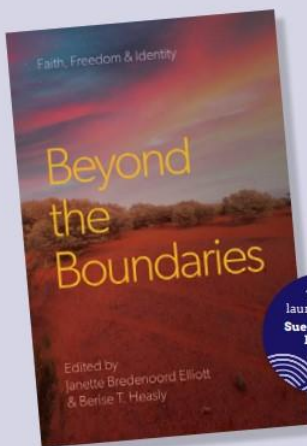
- * Preparation of annual budgets (in conjunction with the Parish Accountant);
 - * Review of the quarterly financial statements, including revenue to budget performance and actions;
 - * Review for future capital and major refurbishment works to the Parish assets;
 - * Endorse the annual accounts for the PC prior to the Annual Audit;
 - * Coordinate the Annual Audit process and
 - * Assist the Parish Priest on any other financial or regulatory matters.
