THE VOICE - UNDERPINNING RECONCILIATION, OR A DIVISIVE POLITICAL FOOTBALL?

The Federal Government intends to launch a referendum later this year as to whether or not Australians agree to add to our Constitution an explicit provision for Aborigines and Torres Strait Islanders to have a voice to Parliament on matters that affect them.

Already there are dissenting voices among citizens, politicians and even some Indigenous people. The "No" arguments appear to include poor understanding of the Constitution, false fears, and disingenuous cases put forward. Can we reach an informed view before we vote?

Our presenter, **Fr Frank Brennan SJ**, currently Rector at Newman College, the University of Melbourne, is well-known as a lawyer and social justice advocate. Formerly In charge of Jesuit Social Services, he was made an Officer of the Order of Australia in 1995 for his services to Aboriginal Australians. His latest book *An Indigenous Voice to Parliament – considering a constitutional bridge* has been released just recently.
