REFERENDUM ON THE VOICE

VOICE FROM ROME

During the week, Rector of Melbourne's Newman College, Fr Frank Brennan SJ, spoke at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. He said that while only eight out of 44 referendums have succeeded since Federation, he hopes "this one will be the ninth".

He said, "May the Australian people bring the country to Yes, recognising the rights of our First Peoples who have occupied the Great South Land of the Holy Spirit for tens of thousands of years." Fr Brennan met with Pope Francis and presented a copy of his book on An Indigenous Voice to Parliament. He dedicated his copy to Pope Francis with an inscription, "Hoping and praying for an

Indigenous Voice to parliament".

Also meeting the Pope this week was Indigenous elder and Australian Senior of the Year Miriam-Rose Ungunmerr Baumann. She opened an exhibition of her art in the Vatican Museum- "We Found God in Nature", and has had meetings with various Vatican officials, with Ambassadors to the Vatican of countries with indigenous populations, with Caritas Internationalis and with leaders of women's religious congregations. The Indigenous voice is being heard in high places in Rome!
