Responsorial Psalm: The Lord is my shepherd;

there is nothing I shall want

<u>Second Reading</u>: <u>1 Corinthians 15:20-26. 28</u>. When all has been subjected to Christ, all will be one in Him.

<u>Gospel Acclamation</u>: Alleluia, alleluia! Blessings on him who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessings on the coming kingdom of our father David! Alleluia!

<u>Gospel</u>: <u>Matthew 25:31-46</u>. Whenever you serve the least of people, you serve Christ.

This Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> November marks the last Sunday of the liturgical year with the Church celebrating the *Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe*, or *Christ the King*. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.
