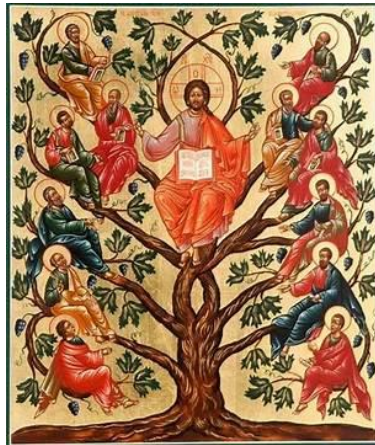

Brought up by the Sisters of Santa Maria, she received an excellent musical education in the orphanage's music school, where she was part of Antonio Vivaldi's famous all-female choir and orchestra. Agatha's Cantata is heard alongside Vivaldi's Magnificat (which was written for the orphans), and other Venetian treasures.
