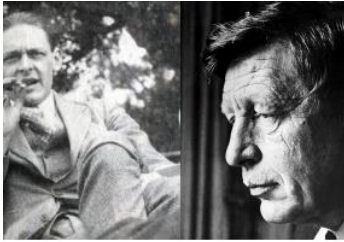
### Migrant Youth Festival - Sunday 29 September 2024
