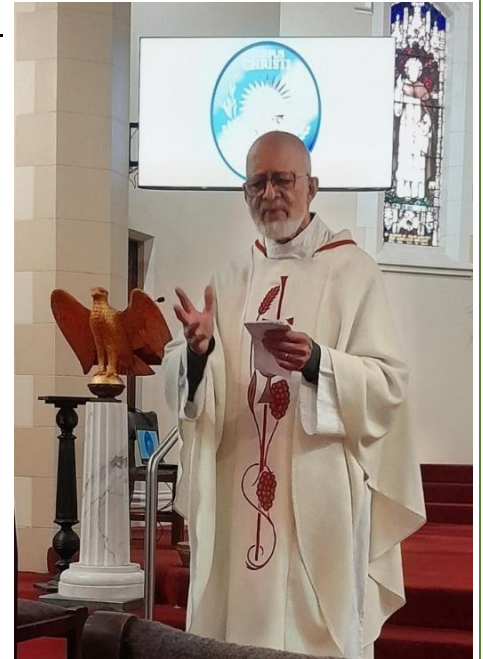

The Sacramental Program

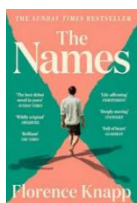

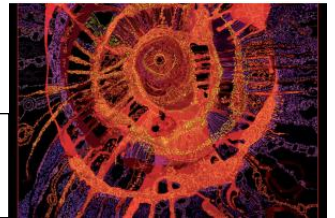
Columbarium Update.
